## **Individual Case Reports**

A property owner in the shire of Narrogin was prosecuted for damaging vegetation. In an attempt to transport inspectors into a salt flat he broke a branch to gain access for a vehicle. The case was dismissed in the courts.

A farmer in the Gin Gin area was threatened with prosecution for clearing by grazing. The farmer had been consistently grazing cattle on his property for a number of years. He was visited by departmental inspectors and notified that he would be prosecuted. The case was finally withdrawn after intervention from a sitting member.

A farmer in the Moora region of WA was threatened with prosecution for causing a fire to stray into a small patch of vegetation located within his property. This was due to a wind change during a burning of stubble operation. No vegetation was permanently damaged. After some time the case was withdrawn
