I have writen to leaders of the past and waited a long time for an action plan of preparedness for extreme weather events. Please don't disappoint again. It is too important to ignore. We are fighting on several fronts now. Low carbon economy was necessary yesterday and prearedness for the consequence is essential now.

More energy in the atmosphere has got to mean more extreme weather fluctuations.

Our plans should include

- 1)Smaller localised democratised weather resistant energy systems with teams to support them when they fail
- 2)regional preparedness because as low lying islands disappear more refugees will be created by our lack of action.
