Dear Dr Dermody

We refer to the email from Mr Alan Raine dated 5 May 2015 which listed two additional questions on notice to be answered by PwC.

We provide our response to these questions as follows:

1. How many new staff has PwC hired across their Australian operations from the ATO since 1 January 2014?

Based on our review of the relevant information available, there are 4 staff members who were employed from the ATO and joined PwC since 1 January 2014.

2. How many staff have left PwC to commence employment at the ATO since 1 January 2014?

The exact number is unknown as we cannot track future employers. We do however ask staff to voluntarily provide this information in their exit interviews and since 1 January 2014 there isn't any information that indicates that a staff member has left PwC to work for the ATO.

We trust that this sufficiently answers the additional questions you have put to us.
