**Senator David Shoebridge** – Well you see EIGIGU Solutions is a fully state-owned Nauruan corporation, isn't it? And the current Minister responsible for it is President Adiang. That's right, isn't it?

**Mr Peter Manwaring** – Senator, I'm aware that EIGIGU Solutions Corporation is a state-owned enterprise of the Government of Nauru. That's correct.

**Senator David Shoebridge** – And the current chair is the President's brother, and a director is David Aingimea, the brother of Lionel, the former President. That's the current make-up of EIGIGU Solutions, isn't it?

**Mr Peter Manwaring** – Senator, I don't have that detail with me. I'll need to take it on notice.
