Requests the Public Affairs Commission in consultation with NATSIAC to prepare resources, including summaries and theological reflections for use by Anglican parishes, schools and organisations, on the Referendum Council Report on any subsequent referendum questions and on the progress of treaty or similar negotiations.

Resolution from the Perth Anglican Synod on 7 October 2017

That this Synod:

- 1 Supports the recommendation of the Referendum Council for a constitutionally entrenched First Nations' voice to the Commonwealth Parliament;
- 2 supports the principle that a treaty or similar agreement should be negotiated between governments and First Nations' peoples;
- 3 writes to the Prime Minister, Leader of the Federal Opposition as well as the Premier and Leader of the Opposition in Western Australia to convey this support;
- 4 requests the Social Responsibilities Commission, as allowed by its budget, to distribute or create summaries of:
- a the Referendum Council Report,
- b any questions to be put to a referendum, and
- c information concerning treaty negotiations, along with theological reflections; and
- 5 encourages parishes, schools and agencies to use and distribute such materials when available.
