Submission on Gambling Reform and problem gamblers:

- I. I believe that a national cap should now be placed on the number of poker machines in Australia, because:
- a. The more poker machine venues there are, the more *normalised* the use of them becomes in any community.
- b. The state governments who use them so extensively for funding will *never* have a motivation to cap the number and they will continue to grow in number as will all the associated problems.
- c. It is pointless addressing problem gambling while placing more and more enticement venues on every corner.
- d. People on the local government level need Federal support to fight the poker machine venue issue because the State government will never stop pushing them onto small communities.
- e. Small town by small town is being picked off and forced to spend all their rate income fighting the State Government at VCAT when they don't want the gaming venues.
- II. Until such a cap is in place, each small town needs Federal Support at VCAT to fight the State Government forcing these venues on the towns.
