[Response to adverse comment—Inquiry into the quality of governance at Australian higher education providers](#)

Thank you for your correspondence regarding a submission to the Senate Education and Employment Legislation Committee's inquiry into the quality of governance at Australian higher education providers, which contains adverse comments about the Office of the Commonwealth Ombudsman (the Office).

As Section 8 of the *Ombudsman Act 1976* requires the Office to conduct investigations in private, this response does not comment on the specifics of the investigation described in the submission.

Rather, I make a general comment on the use of Ombudsman's powers under the Ombudsman Act. The current Ombudsman has made clear his intention, where appropriate, to use the full suite of powers available to him under the Ombudsman Act¹. The Office's Investigations Policy supports this intention by outlining the use of section 9 of the Ombudsman Act², which the submission refers to, as one of several methods to obtain information.
