Re: Comments – National Gambling Reform Bill 2012

Maxgaming is pleased to have the opportunity to offer comment on the National Gambling Reform Bill 2012.

Maxgaming has proven precommitment technology and is the exclusive monitoring operator to all gaming machines (hotels and clubs) in NSW and the Northern Territory and over 81% of the Queensland market.

The capital and operating costs to support a Precommitment System as required under the Bill will be significantly influenced by the ability of the approved Precommitment System supplier to leverage existing monitoring systems and associated wide area and in-venue LAN communications networks, and, the extent to which regulatory settings and technical standards support integrating existing player loyalty systems and third party monitoring systems (eg casinos and, in the case of Queensland, two licenced monitoring operators) to facilitate the required EGM data feeds and commands, into an overarching Precommitment System.

Maxgaming looks forward to providing further information, demonstration or other assistance as required.
