Question:

Senator WHISH-WILSON: How many disqualification orders relating to breaches of the CCA or the ACL have been imposed? Just give us an idea. You could take it on notice.

Mr Bezzi: Yes, we might take that on notice. The longest one was against Peter Foster—the notorious Peter Foster.

Answer:

The ACCC has obtained disqualification orders against 17 individuals in 11 separate cases.
