Inquiry into a better family law system to support and protect those affected by family violence

On 23 March 2017, a <u>Committee of the Australian Parliament</u> announced an inquiry into a better family law system to support and protect those affected by family violence.

The inquiry has received 114 submissions including from the Family Court of Australia.

Last night, the Committee passed a resolution postponing today's appearance before the Committee of Chief Justice Diana Bryant AO of the Family Court of Australia and Chief Judge John Pascoe AC of the Federal Circuit Court of Australia.

It did so after concerns were raised by Committee Chair, <u>Sarah Henderson MP</u>, that, given recent proceedings in the Victorian Supreme Court, the Committee should seek the Attorney-General's advice on the appropriateness of senior members of the judiciary appearing for questioning by Members of Parliament before a parliamentary inquiry.
