Response to written question on notice from Senator David Pocock
received 19 September 2025

QON: Does anyone in your organisation currently hold a sponsored pass to Parliament House?

If so, who, and which Member of Parliament sponsors that pass?

Answer: CBA complies with the Parliament House access arrangements outlined in the Parliament House Private Area Access Policy and as administered by the Department of Parliamentary Services (DPS). CBA notes that DPS does not publish a register of sponsored pass holders or release individual card holder information.

In relation to sponsored access card holders with a significant and regular business requirement¹, CBA is aware of six individuals: CBA's Chief Executive Officer and five employees within the Corporate Affairs division, which is responsible for government affairs.
