Public hearing for review of Office of National Intelligence bills

The Parliamentary Joint Committee on Intelligence and Security will hold a public hearing tomorrow as part of its review of the Office of National Intelligence Bill 2018 and the Office of National Intelligence (Consequential and Transitional Provisions) Bill 2018.

The bills implement recommendations of the 2017 Independent Intelligence Review.

The Committee will hear from the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet, Office of National Assessments and Department of Home Affairs.
