Dear All,

Please consider putting buildings at Macquarie Island Station onto platforms that raise and lower according to sea level variations to avoid inundation.

- Advanced engineering would suggest internal deep piers that bring the building up to a safe level using automatic data collecting from sea levels.
- Multiple moveable access stairs and ramps will be beneficial additions to the huts and buildings.
- Sea movements could be captured to generate energy - electricity, to supply the buildings with a constant supply, supporting the raising and lowering of the buildings in the first instance.
