Following my appearance at the Parliamentary Joint Committee on the Australian Commission for Law Enforcement Integrity's *Inquiry into the Integrity of Australia's border arrangements* on Friday 11 September 2020, I have reviewed my evidence and seek to clarify the record.

In response to a question from Senator Bilyk regarding the timing of hearings for Operation Angove, I responded that there were no private hearings after 28 October 2019. In fact, one of the two private hearings was held after this date:

- The first private hearing for Operation Angove was held on 14 October 2019.
- On 18 October 2019 the former Integrity Commissioner announced that public hearings would be held.
- On 28 October 2019 the former Integrity Commissioner announced public hearings would be delayed.
- The second private hearing was on 5 December 2019.
