I am writing to you to express my concern over the government's proposed bill regarding processing of asylum seekers in Australia

As a proud member of the Australian community I am appalled, shocked and ashamed at our government's lack of compassion, lack of procedural fairness and disregard of international obligations and international law. I agree with the Asylum Seekers Advocates who oppose this action and bill, with these basic arguments.

We strongly oppose the Bill on two key principles:

1. ***Abuse of Power*** – *It will see the Minister give himself an unprecedented level of power to make life or death decisions about individual asylum seeker cases, without court oversight.*
2. ***Harm to People*** – *It will cause significant mental suffering and see people returned to danger, persecution, torture and death in their home countries.*
