Men with advanced prostate cancer in the United States are able to be treated successfully with Zytiga or Xtandi before chemotherapy thus extending their pleasant life.

Could the Committee please consider having a look at making the drugs, Zytiga and Xtandi, available in Australia on the National Pharmaceutical Benefits Scheme.
