Helping students gain employment to be discussed

The [Standing Committee on Employment, Education and Training](#), as part of its [inquiry into School to Work Transition](#) will hear from a range of witnesses on Monday and Tuesday in Melbourne and Sydney respectively.

Committee Chair [Mr Andrew Laming MP](#) said the roundtable sessions should provide robust evidence for the inquiry.

“I’m looking forward to engaging with a range of universities and institutes whose focus is on the transition from school to work.” Mr Laming said.

Committee Deputy Chair [Ms Terri Butler MP](#) sees this as an important opportunity for the Committee to hear from a range of stakeholders.
