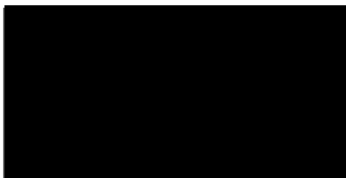
On behalf of the Department of Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development, Communications and the Arts (the department), I am pleased to update the Senate Economics Legislation Committee on the department's submission to the inquiry regarding *Treasury Laws Amendment (2022 Measures No. 4) Bill 2022* (the Bill).

My letter dated 17 January 2023 concerned the key features and eligibility requirements of the Digital Games Tax Offset (the Offset), a program governed by Schedule 1 in the Bill. On 30 January 2023, the Hon Tony Burke MP, Minister for the Arts announced *Revive: a place for every story, a story for every place* – Australia's cultural policy for the next five years.

As part of this plan, the Australian Government is supporting the digital games industry by providing \$12 million over four years to support digital games developers and small and medium independent games studios with project budgets up to \$500,000. This initiative is complementary to the Offset which supports games with budgets over \$500,000. This represents an integrated plan to support the whole of Australia's digital games sector.

The department thanks the Committee for this opportunity to update its submission to the Inquiry.
