Senator McKim asked:

If LNG terminals electrify and reduce gas use in response to the Safeguard Mechanism, would the saved gas be captured by the code of conduct provisions, or could these volumes just be freed up for export?

Answer:

In general terms, the *Competition and Consumer (Gas Market Code) Regulations 2023* apply to gas producers and their affiliates, which includes LNG producers. In the event that an LNG producer reduced its gas usage (for example, as a result of electrification) any additional gas available to it would be subject to the provisions in the Gas Market Code.
