**Senator Don Farrell asked:**

**Senator FARRELL:** Thank you for that. I have one last question and then I will hand back to Ms Templeman. Is it possible for NBN to provide a traffic profile relative to the 28 February pre-COVID baseline that de-trends for additional activations that have occurred during that period? Is that what you're going to provide? Is that the information you're planning to provide me with, or is that—

**Mr Rue:** You'd have to guess what we would have achieved pre COVID with what we actually achieved.

**Senator FARRELL:** Right.

**Mr Rue:** I think we're slightly ahead of our budget, but I'm not sure whether that necessarily reflects your question. Just to be clear: we're very happy to provide you with whatever you are asking, but I just want to make sure we know what you're asking.

**Senator FARRELL:** But for what occurred during COVID, are you able to provide the traffic profile of average traffic per hour per user?

**Mr Rue :** Yes, let's have a go. I don't have that; we'll have to take that on notice.
