Melbourne. At about 1yo i was
featured on the front page of the
herald sun due to the custody battle
my parents were in all the strain
and emotion they must of been under
from having me must of been huge,
during that court battle there was
a D.N.A test done to prove that
my father ~~is~~ on my birth certificate
was not my real bio-logical father
that must of been really hard for
my father and i don't think anyone
should have to go through that
especially after the hoops that they had
to jump through to have me and the
embarrassment or pain he might of felt
when findind out he could not have
children due to a low sperm count.

I call him my father or DAD to him
because that is what he is to me he has
partly raised me and always treated me as
his son this is something i want to make

Clear from the start.

My Mother won Custody and my father got the odd weekend and half the school holidays once i was old enough for school. I was living with my mum in melbourne at my grandparents house with my uncle aswell. My father stayed on his dairy farm in N.S.W Just over the border from the hospital i was born at We lived $3\frac{1}{2}$ hours ~~away~~ apart which made visiting difficult especially for a dairy farmer but i can rememer visits to and from my fathers they were few but i can remember them at least.

Mum told me that i was donar conceived and about the birds + the bees to try and help me understand when i was about 5yo. At that age even being taught the birds + bees

i never really comprehended the enormity of it. I just went on being a kid. Growing up i went to a school a few suburbs away i had friends at school but in my neighbourhood i never really had any close friends so i spent more time at home i had my grandfather i looked up to he passed away when i was 4 and i had my uncle who i was best mates with because i mainly lived in melbourne my uncle was the main role model which was great but we were not father + son and around my teenage years he had found his wife and moved on and i seen less + less of him we were still close over the years but never as close as when i was growing up, he passed away around 5 years ago and i miss him greatly.

My father never mentioned anything around the fact that i was donor conceived.

Over the years of visits on school hols, etc

and times when i lived up there
for ~~3~~ a year ~~to~~ here + there
because i was playing up (Rebel/ing)
down in melb and mum was
finding it hard to control me.

Whilst i was up there i never
~~brought~~ brought it to him because of fear
that it might hurt him, fear of him
rejecting me and not wanting anything
to do with me and probably some other
reasons that im not sure of so we
just went on living a somewhat
normal father + son relationship but all
the while i knew he was not my
bio-logical father and i never knew if
he knew that i knew. It was never
really a normal father, son relationship
with all that doubt there.

~~During my late teens, early twenties~~
Growing up i always felt different
i was the only person i knew of
in my situation everyone i know
had a different kind of bond with
their father even if their parents were
seperated the bond with their father

seemed a lot more real. During my late teens and early twenties i got in touch with the Donor Conception Support Group over the phone and got to know Leoni Hewitt who has done massive amounts of work ~~for~~ supporting donor conceived children and adults she was very supportive to me in a very hard time in my life and told me that i was not alone her three children are just like me she also introduced me to other adults conceived through donor insemination.

Around about the same time as connecting with the D.C.S.G i wrote to melbourne I.V.F with the help from my mum in the hope to get more information on my biological father. I wanted to know things like any hereditary illnesses i might be susceptible to, what country his family was originally from and whether or not i look like him, I look a lot like my mothers family but do i look a lot more like my ~~father~~ biological father. I received a letter with

like me i am 6ft with brown or Auburn
hair and blue/green eyes.

The letter went on to say that the
sperm that created me was also used
to create 2 males and 1 female in
3 other families this was new and
shocking news to me this brought a
whole new issue into it for me, who
are these 3 people half the same as
me, do they look like me, do they
know they are donor conceived, do they
wonder about me amongst other questions.

A couple of years later we wrote in
again not sure why i ~~still~~ didn't think
that id get any more information but theres
no harm in trying but apparently there is
harm in trying i received a letter back
that was a photo copy of the previous letter
with the part about my half siblings
removed or whited out this confused me
then it turned to anger. I was confused
as to wheather or not i really had any half
siblings out there maybe they made a mistake

or maybe they had made a mistake as to wheather they were allowed to tell me this information but then i got angry because how could an organization that is in control of half of some peoples identities and in control of creating life could make mistakes like that.

A few years later i wrote in again and i received a more formal letter with the same ~~of~~ information on my biological father but i got a little more information on my half siblings it was only birth dates not exact but they said the 2 males were born ~~in~~ circa feb and circa may 1978 then for the female it had an exact date of which is my birthdate

at first i entertained the thought of a half twin from another mother and how crazy ~~that~~ and awesome that would be but then i knew i had to contact melbourne LWF to make sure of this but i was to find out that this was a type-o

To sum up if the laws around A.I.D were changed there would be some information about my biological father ; i would like to know but i don't think i would have to meet him and i definatly wouldn't want anything from him i already have a father and he will always be my father

As for my half siblings i would like to meet them if that is what they wanted and if they didn't i would respect their choice but with the laws as they are at the moment we don't ~~do~~ even have that choice to make for ourselves
