**Ms Templeman asked:**

**Ms TEMPLEMAN:** Can I pick up on something that both Senator Griff and Dr Haines have talked about: the extra funds for emergency communication. We have been talking about the muster trucks, which look terrific, but of the 2,000 NBN satellite services across the country to rural and country fire services and designated evacuation centres is there a list yet of where they will go?

**Mr Williams:** There's an evolving list. We've been engaging with states and territories to determine target locations. Essentially we've built two phases into the program, which identify those locations that we've been advised and requested to install right now—that's the urgent sites—and others that will be installed at the time. I'm not sure that there's a published list, but I have a list of a number that we're looking to install. We are in conversations with states and territories to confirm the details to install those. We're ready and eager to go. The reality is that there are some states and territories that are unable to identify a clear—in a large number with the uncertainties of the season. We've got a number in the order of a couple of hundred in that first list. We're looking to ensure that we pre-stage equipment in regions so that we can reactively respond where the targeted need is in the event of a disaster. Equally, if we can get the steer on an install we're ready and eager to effect that install.

**Ms TEMPLEMAN:** Are you able to make that list public to us?

**Mr Williams:** I'd need to confirm whether there's any commercial in confidence basis for that list—if whatever reason it wouldn't be public. I'd need to check, for example, with the states as well that they've—

**Ms TEMPLEMAN:** Sure. If you could check that and advise us I would appreciate that. I would also be specifically interested if there are any locations in the local government areas of the Hawkesbury or the Blue Mountains.

**Mr Rue:** We have no issues with that. We just need to check with other people to—

**Ms TEMPLEMAN:** I understand that.

**Mr Rue:** Even though [inaudible] specific reason, we will certainly see if we can check your particular are for problems—

**Ms TEMPLEMAN:** Thank you.
