TAFE inquiry heads to Townsville

The Standing Committee on Education and Employment will be in Townsville tomorrow 07 May 2014, to continue its public hearing schedule for the inquiry into TAFE and its operations with a roundtable hearing to be held at the Townsville Trade Training Centre.

The Committee is investigating the issues surrounding skills development, employment and further education pathways and the operation of a competitive training market. The Committee will meet with local business and industry representatives from Townsville and the surrounding areas to learn how these issues affect the wider community and receive feedback on suggested areas of improvement.

The Committee Chair and local Member for Herbert, Mr Ewen Jones MP, anticipates a robust discussion on TAFE which will provide valuable insight for the Committee.

“A healthy TAFE system is an important commodity to the community as a whole, as is a skilled and educated workforce. Getting the balance right between public and private training providers and educators, as well as ensuring that students receive quality training outcomes and pathways is crucial in supporting Australia’s economic future,” he said.
