To clarify the ACC's requirements in regard to the The Crime's Legislation Bill 2010 Amendments relating to the appointment of ACC examiners. The ACC is seeking this amendment to provide more flexibility to the way we conduct examinations.

The requirement is two fold:

- To appoint examiners on a part-time basis this would be a permanent part time arrangement for a specified number of hours on a fixed term period; and
- To appoint examiners so that ACC could draw on a pool on an as needs basis determined by operational requirements.

This will allow the ACC to:

- approach examinations in a more strategic way (for example, by drawing from a pool of examiners as operational needs require)
- use different examiners for different purposes depending on the particular type of investigation or operation (for example, utilising different skills depending on the person being examined), and
- appoint examiners in different regions of Australia.
