Driverless Vehicles inquiry in Brisbane

Wednesday 3 May 2017 Public Hearing in Brisbane

The <u>Parliamentary Innovations Committee</u> will be in Brisbane on Wednesday to hold a public hearing <u>into its driverless vehicles inquiry</u>.

Committee Chair, <u>Michelle Landry MP</u>, noted that driverless vehicles continue to be of interest to the public as more people come to understand the potential benefits and possible concerns around the introduction and increased use of automated driving technologies.

"The Committee has held a number of hearings and inspections now", Ms Landry noted, "and each one of those has given us more to think about. Driverless vehicles will affect road safety, mobility and accessibility, employment, urban design, agriculture and mining, the environment and many other aspects of life".

In Brisbane, the Committee will be hearing from academics from the Queensland University of Technology and the Centre for Human Factors and Sociotechnical Systems at the University of the Sunshine Coast, industry group Motor Trades Australia Queensland and Swarm Farm Robotics, the Queensland company building autonomous vehicles with agricultural uses.
