Senator DAVID POCOCK: One last one to either department of infrastructure or Infrastructure Australia, on the stage 2 assessment on page 31. I'm interested if the MOF modules are part of the LNG or other petrochemical plants. Are they unloading LNG facilities at a facility we are paying for? How is that working?

Mr Tucker: I'm sorry, I can't recall the specifics that were set out in that stage 2—

**Answer:**

The Stage 2 submission for the Middle Arm Sustainable Development Precinct identifies that the Modular offloading facility (MOF) will enable transport of large pre-assembled modules to be imported for construction, although specific users/proponents are not identified.
