Can you provide the number and names of services that have been found non-compliant with the required standards? What regulatory action was taken?

Answer:

Between 1 March 2020 and 31 May 2020, the Commission made findings of new non-compliance with the required standards at 104 services.

The Commission took the following regulatory actions between 1 March 2020 and 31 March 2020:

Sanctions: 2

Notices To Agree: 4

Non-Compliance Notices: 23

Directions to revise Plan for Continuous Improvement: 75¹

The Commission publishes regulatory actions relating to sanctions, notices to agree and non-compliance notices.

Answer:

Between 1 March 2020 and 31 May 2020, the Commission has conducted 107 visits to services in relation to COVID-19 readiness. These services were assessed as high risk through various intelligence sources.
