The WA fruit industry is particularly focused on minimising any impact on farming practises during the revue process for potentially problematic chemicals. The WA fruit industry believes the APVMA needs the power to enforce compliance with its regulatory decisions and would most importantly like to see greater consultation of the Agricultural industry during the review process.
