Question:

How much has been spent/paid out to date on the following measures:

- a. The Coronavirus Supplement
- b. \$750 payments to support households

Answer:

As at 28 August 2020, total outlays for the Coronavirus Supplement and the two Economic Support Payments are as follows:

- a. The Coronavirus Supplement- \$11.0 billion across all eligible payments.
- b. Economic Support Payments-
 - \$5.3 billion for the first Economic Support Payment, paid from March 2020.
 - \$3.5 billion for the second Economic Support Payment, paid from July 2020.

The above outlays do not include payments to Department of Veterans' Affairs clients.
