INQUIRY INTO NDIS INDEPENDENT ASSESSMENTS

The Joint Standing Committee on the National Disability Insurance Scheme is aware of the agreement reached during the [Disability Reform Ministers' meeting](#) on Friday 9 July 2021 that Independent Assessments will not proceed (as recommended by the Independent Advisory Council). The [Communique](#) from the meeting was released earlier today (Wednesday 14 July 2021).

The committee's inquiry is ongoing. The committee will continue to review the evidence it has received regarding Independent Assessments and intends to table a report in Parliament later this year.
