Inquiry into the Migration Amendment (Regional Processing Cohort) Bill 2019

I refer to your email of 11 July 2019.

The Legal Services Commission of South Australia provides legal advice and assistance in on-shore migration matters only. Many such matters come before the Administrative Appeals Tribunal where a number concern problems with visas. The Commission supports the proposed changes which would enable the Minister to permit a member of the designated regional processing cohort, or a class of persons within the designated regional processing cohort, to make a valid application for a visa if the Minister thinks it is in the public interest to do so. We also support the decision not to apply the visa ban to children.
