Inquiry: The environmental, social and economic impacts of large-capacity fishing vessels commonly known as 'Supertrawlers' operating in Australia's marine jurisdiction.

I have serious concerns about allowing supertrawlers to operate in Australian waters for the following reasons:

- 1. The risk of localized overfishing which will affect ecosystem function.
- 2. Impaired ecosystem function could affect other users such as small scale commercial fishers and recreational fishers.
- 3. Some of the target species for the supertrawler are the prey of threatened species such as the little penguin which will impact upon their populations.
