Senator MOORE: Okay, and staffing issues on SDGs is the whole of the DFAT budget. How much did the voluntary report cost? You can't tell me that's the whole DFAT budget.

Ms Aeuckens: We don't have those figures.

Senator MOORE: The voluntary report was a very concrete project. You may have to take this on notice.

Ms Aeuckens: I think we will have to take that on notice.

Senator MOORE: What was the cost of the resources involved in developing the voluntary review generally? If we can have that itemised, that would be good.

Mr Tinning: Do you want direct or indirect cost? We had five staff working on it, three of whom we took off other jobs, so I guess it depends whether you want a full cost, a direct budget cost or both.

Senator MOORE: Both.

Mr Tinning: Okay, we'll do that.

Staffing Costs

At peak staffing (2017/2018) the 2030 Agenda work in DFAT was led by a team of 4.49 full-time equivalent staff. This included one EL2, two EL1 and two APS6 staff. Not all were full time and they worked on a range of matters, including coordination of the 2030 Agenda and Voluntary National Review. SES officers had oversight of the work. This answer reflects information previously provided in QoN 142, October 2017.
