Dear Senator Williams, Just a follow up to my earlier submission to the Senate Enquiry into the operation and regulation of mobility scooters. There are requirements for motorists and cyclists to have blood alcohol below prescribed levels when in charge of their vehicle. I note there does not appear to be any prescribed level of blood alcohol for people using a mobility scooter. I expect this is as a result of their status as “pedestrians” in terms of the road rules. Perhaps this could be considered in the enquiry and I would be grateful if you could bring it to the attention of the Committee, Trevor Hodson.
