



Public Works Committee to hold public hearing for development and construction of housing for Defence at RAAF Base Darwin, NT

The Public Works Committee is holding a public hearing on Monday in Darwin, for its inquiry into the development and construction of housing for Defence at RAAF Base Darwin, NT.

The Department of Defence and Defence Housing Australia propose to provide 80 tropical dwellings in a new on-base housing precinct, to meet the housing entitlements of junior Defence members. The project will also address current substandard infrastructure.

The estimated cost of the project is \$53.36 million. The civil construction contract is expected to begin in October 2014, with the dwelling construction contract to commence in July 2015. The dwellings are expected to be completed by November 2016.
