Here in Victoria, over 20% of our State is tied up in State and National Parks. I would presume it is more or less the same for all states. Also much of our State Forests are being removed from production.

We already have schemes such as 'Land for Wildlife' and the 'CarbonSmart' Scheme run through the Landcare movement. Why do we need any schemes that take productive farmland out of production?

The great lie that was *Anthropogenic Global Warming* has been exposed for the falsity that it always was!

Much of our great country is being continually destroyed by bushfire.
