It affects them EMOTIONALLY as they have started their young life here. The girls from CHINA, take nothing from our government. They pay big money to go to uni here; they pay full fair on buses and trains; they all have health cover, when they get their P.R. they work. They are only children, so they don't have a heap of brothers and sisters and their wife ect that they want to bring into Australia, I think you should all hang your heads in shame the way these young girls are treated, when they try and come to this country in the right manner, I feel as though we are just taking their money for they pay big money to go to uni here, and all they end up with is a big bag of degrees worth nothing if they cannot get P.R. The IELTS is also a big take, they pay \$350 a pop, and it is like trying to win lotto each time they go for it, and some go for it five times or more, I have seen them get for example, Speaking the first times they do it get 8 or 9 and then next time 6 or 5. How could this be possible IT IS UNFAIR!

There are people who have been let into this country who don't go to work; don't fit in with our ways and never will. NSW TAFE pays \$65 per hour to teachers to teach them English, they pay nothing, so I would like to see these girls get a fair go, and for our government to stop changing their minds from day to day. Yes, I do believe Migration should be slowed down, but it should be everyone who (ARRIVES) in Australia after 01/07/2010.
