To the Honourable members of the Senate Committee.

To roll back the 2006 shared parenting reforms would take us, as a nation, back to the dark ages. When all evidence is taken into account, it can be plainly seen that the children won a great victory in 2006. We now have less suicides and less fatal child abuse.
