We are aware that there have been some media reports of children not being able to access care. The data points that we have suggest this does remain a small minority of children. We've had about 128 calls and emails about child care services refusing to accept new enrolments or increase days and/or hours in the department, which is about one one-hundredth of a per cent of the children that we have in care at the moment.
