Professor Brailsford

Senator KIM CARR: Yes. Let me just get this straight. If we look at a sub-bachelor program in 2015, is it \$22,800 for a diploma?

Prof. Brailsford: I will have to take that on notice, but that does sound to be a figure that is certainly in the ball park.

Response: The fee is \$22,880

Senator KIM CARR: And \$32,528 for an undergraduate diploma in university English?

Prof. Brailsford: That sounds to be approximately correct, but as to the exact figure I would have to take that on notice.

Response: Correct. The Undergraduate Diploma in University English Studies \$32,528.

Senator RHIANNON: What about domestic students from non-English-speaking backgrounds and regional students? Do you have figures on that?

Prof. Brailsford: I do not have that information and will have to take that on notice.

Response: Proportion of domestic undergraduate students from Non-English speaking background: 0.18%

Proportion of domestic undergraduate Regional/Remote students: 11.60%
