Wind farms are ridiculously expensive, their output of electricity is only a small percentage of what they are alleged to produce, because the wind is too variable, and the turbines have to be shut down when the wind is too strong, and of course they don't work when the wind isn't blowing.

They are a completely inefficient and expensive way of producing electricity and their output is too variable, which destabilises the grid. They CANNOT produce baseload power.

They are also ugly, have bad health effects on people living near them, kill birds, and need a lot of maintenance.

They are built as a form of "greenwashing", trying to bolster the "AGW Climate Change" meme which the Government is using in order to tax and control the people.

If people were really concerned about "climate change", then they would be proposing nuclear power stations.
