Dear Senator

Thank you for your email of 30 May 2014 inviting the Queensland Government to make a submission to the parliamentary inquiry into the Asset Recycling Fund Bill 2014 (the Bill) and the Asset Recycling Fund (Consequential Amendments) Bill 2014.

The Queensland Government agrees with the concept of asset recycling and broadly supports the Bill and its associated amendments.

The Queensland Government supports the presence of an investment mandate and the associated reporting obligations to which the Asset Recycling Fund (ARF) would be bound. This will help to ensure the transparency and accountability of the initiative.

From a Queensland perspective, it is encouraging to note that ARF would focus on providing funding, financial assistance and incentives in order to support the development of new infrastructure to boost economic growth.

However, given the recent reduction in funding for national partnership agreements with Queensland, we would request that any funding from ARF be additional to funding currently provided by the Federal Government and not subject to GST equalisation.
