

The Senate Standing Committees on Economics

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I have been pushing this issue here in South Australia with both State and Federal representatives for a long time, in order to get much needed manufacturing in Murray Bridge South Australia in the future.

I have attached my information, based on a lot of information regarding the likelihood of China going to war, because of several issues that have a very high priority for the Chinese.

**Regrettably too many indicators are pointing to this fact!
But will Australia be found highly vulnerable?**

Even if Australia is not directly involved (highly unlikely) the means of receiving any products from China, Japan, Korea, Vietnam, and Taipei, etc. are close to zero!

Today we need to categorise and prioritise all products by the level of how critical their need is!

One way we can do that, is by checking import listings by quantity within a one year time frame, followed by prioritising strategic products and items by their importance for maintaining our sovereignty, including such as items that are not imported, but will have an increased role to play in our defence!

Manufacturing

Based on the above prioritising of all products, we then urgently need to build industries that will allow Australia to maintain its sovereignty for centuries to come.

But this must be done strategically right across Australia, so that there will be local synergy of parts, when producing products. For instance, when building electric cars/trucks and vans, building the batteries should be close by, and also close to highways to distribute the end products.

All manufacturing industries should utilize to its full extent **Artificial Intelligence** and **3D printing** to speed up production, and to enable any rapid adjustments where needed!

Such “micro factories” are starting to pot up in the UK and the USA producing state of the art vans and cars, but can be utilized to produce a plethora of different products including rockets etc. and those micro factories also work 24/7 with minimal oversight.

3D printing

Those 3D printing machines can produce quality metal parts with a very high degree of accuracy in a fraction of time. 3D printing machines can also utilize many different materials such as concrete to build a 3 story house in a few days, and plastic to produce many parts to build a car, a bus, a boat, or a plane.

Batteries

Long lasting, and reliable batteries for cars, vans, buses and trucks are well advanced, and should be made in Australia.

Mining
