In 2014 I was sacked from After 23 years as a Tafe teacher because I tried to expose a case of timetable fraud by 2 of my colleagues which was occurring over many years. The following is a very brief summary of my experiences:

1. I asked for help From HR about how to go about making my complaint/ Public disclosure

2. I followed HR's advise in making my complaint/public disclosure.

3. I asked for and was denied whistleblower protection.

4. Certain HR personnel fabricated Statutory Declarations (I have proof) in order to silence me quickly and have me dismissed in order to bury my complaint/disclosure.

5, I eventually Got the CCC to mount an independent investigation into my claims.

6. I was denied access (and therefore possible justice) to the results of this investigation by the CCC as it was "deemed not to be in the publics' best interest" .

I will not waste too much time telling my entire story as history so far has shown that no one really cares but in the unlikely event that you actually do care feel free to call me on . It will take at least an hour to tell my story and present my evidence. I have been unemployed ever since my dismissal, my career, my superannuation and my good name have all been destroyed because I chose to do the right thing and expose wrong doing within this government organisation.
