

Dear Senate Committee members,

I urge the committee to recommend that the Sex Discrimination Amendment (Sexual Orientation, Gender Identity and Intersex Status) Bill 2013 should not be made law.

The additional grounds of 'sexual orientation' and 'gender identity' should not be added to the Sex Discrimination Act 1984. Not only do these grounds depend only on a person's chosen identity or behaviour, but anything other than sexual orientation between a man and his wife, and any gender identity different from the one God has given to us are sin. The very rare genetic or developmental condition resulting in intersex condition is different, however, and my submission will not deal with this aspect of the Bill.

Furthermore, the exemptions solely for religious bodies, charities and religious schools are completely inadequate for the vast majority of Christians. The many Christians who run or are employed by businesses would be forced by law to act against their conscience in choosing who to hire or do business with.

When similar laws to prevent 'discrimination' against homosexuals were passed in the UK, there were many examples of Christians who were fined or lost their jobs.
