Senator Kristina Keneally asked:

Since 20 March 2020, which Commonwealth agency or agencies has been overall responsibility for monitoring the implementation of quarantine in Australia?

Answer:

As agreed by National Cabinet, State and Territory Governments have put in place quarantine capacity in their respective jurisdictions and are responsible for the implementation and management of their arrangements..

Quarantine issues are regularly discussed at National Cabinet meetings which are coordinated by the Department of Prime Minister and Cabinet.
