



Investigating service delivery on Christmas Island

The Department of Infrastructure and Regional Development (DIRD) manages the provision of housing, fire and emergency and environmental regulation on Christmas and the Cocos (Keeling) Islands and this provision will be the subject of a public hearing in Canberra on Thursday 15 October.

As the Commonwealth department with responsibility for the territories, DIRD works with WA agencies to provide these services.

The National Capital and External Territories Committee will continue discussions with DIRD as hearings continue for its inquiry into governance in the Indian Ocean Territories.
