Can the Minister confirm that the Infection Control Expert Group (ICEG) has members that have specific experience or training in pandemic / epidemic infections as opposed to hospital infection only?

a. If so, which members have this experience or training?

**Answer:**

The Infection Control Expert Group (ICEG) provides expert advice to the Australian Health Protection Principal Committee (AHPPC) to support best practice related to infection prevention and control in the community, hospitals and other health care settings. The membership of ICEG consists of expert infection prevention and control practitioners, specialist microbiologists, and infectious diseases physicians. The membership also includes the current president of the faculty of occupational and environmental medicine in the Royal Australasia College of Physicians.

The collective membership of ICEG reflects health care practitioners with extensive experience in hospital practice, public health response to communicable diseases, health emergency management, biological safety and containment, and workplace health and safety. The membership of ICEG is drawn from across the states and territories to establish a national body of expertise.

Specialist microbiologists and infectious diseases physicians practice is not confined to hospital populations but also to community health care. Specialist microbiologists and infectious diseases physicians regularly work in the interface with public health authorities on communicable diseases.
