I am not sure if in my submission i put that the social worker (...) (...) worked for childrens services he was also in that community i was in . Years later i contacted him to find out where my daughter was and he replied and said to me what your own flesh and blood and i said yes. He said he could lose his job over this and he said he told them what they were doing was dangerous. i dont know what he meant but when i went to the newspapers with my story a friend of his rang me and said if i wanted to see my daughter i couldnt go public. so of course i didnt at that time think it was 1991that i contacted thecourier mail. you have my permission to attach this to the bottom of my inquiry.

Also the community i was in said prayers that god would have a good home picked out for my baby well god already did she was in my belly. powerful stuff that the love i had for my firstborn is like no other
