## **Terms of Reference**

That the Joint Standing Committee on the National Disability Insurance Scheme inquire into and report by 19 June 2026:

- a) the nature and extent of non-compliance, including fraud and sharp practices, in the National Disability Insurance Scheme
- b) the impacts of non-compliance on NDIS participants and their families
- c) the effectiveness and adequacy of successive government policies to improve scheme integrity, safeguard participants, and tackle non-compliance
- d) any legislative or other reforms required to strengthen scheme integrity.
